APPLY IT

David did not look like a king or a mighty warrior, but God chose him to be king over Israel and gave him victory over Goliath. The Israelites were too weak and afraid to face Goliath; they needed David to fight on their behalf. In a similar way, though Jesus did not look like a warrior or king, we need Him to fight for us. Jesus gives us victory over sin and death.

Make a poster or sign to hang in your room that says "Jesus fights for me." Anytime you feel scared or overwhelmed this week, look at the sign and repeat this prayer:

Prayer: Jesus, thank you so much that you fight for me. You give me victory over all my sin and over everything I am afraid of. I can trust you. Amen.

September 20: David Showed Mercy



David showed mercy even though Saul hated him.

MAIN IDEA

David showed Saul mercy when he shouldn't have because he knew God would protect him from Saul.

KEY PASSAGE

1 Samuel 24



David showed mercy to Saul, his enemy, because David trusted God's plan. Jesus showed mercy to His enemies because He trusted God's plan.




Each person stands on one foot and takes turns rolling the dice. When the person rolls a DOUBLE 6, that person can put his/her leg down. 
APPLY IT

October 18: David's Psalm


